The Oxnard City Council unanimously supports this self-serving INCUMBENT PROTECTION scheme. That's precisely why you should vote No.

**I.
NAME OF CORPORATION**

The name of this corporation is MOVING OXNARD FORWARD, INC. (hereinafter *see* referred to as the "Corporation").

**II.
NATURE OF CORPORATION**

This corporation is a NONPROFIT PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public purposes. [California Corporations Code §5130.]

**III.
PURPOSE OF CORPORATION**

The specific purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

1. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to promote social welfare within the meaning of section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code, including but not limited to: (a) developing and advocating for legislation and regulations to promote private sector alternatives to local government services; (b) promoting the adoption, implementation and public awareness of policies and ordinances necessary to improve the business climate and lower the cost of operating a business; and (c) conducting research and publicizing the positions of elected officials concerning these issues.

This corporation is not organized for profit, and no part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member of the Board of Directors or any other individual except that this corporation may make payments of reasonable compensation for services rendered.

The corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office to an extent that would disqualify it from tax exemption under section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code. The corporation shall never be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit.

Notwithstanding any provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law).

2. To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

**IV.
DURATION**

The period of duration for this corporation shall be perpetual or until such time as the Board of Directors shall adopt a resolution recommending that the corporation be dissolved pursuant to applicable state and federal requirements.

**V.
TAX-EXEMPT STATE OF CORPORATION**

1. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for Social Welfare purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.

2. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to Social Welfare purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, all assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for Social Welfare purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code.

**VI.
AGENT FOR SERVICE OF PROCESS**

**VII.
CORPORATE ADDRESSES**

**VIII.
STOCK**

This corporation shall not have authority to issue capital stock.

**IX.
AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any of the provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, with notice by an affirmative vote of the majority of the members of the Board of Directors.

**X.
FUNDS AND ASSETS**

This corporation shall use its funds only to accomplish the purposes stated in these Articles of Incorporation. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to, and only to, one or more charitable or social welfare organizations.


